 False Saviors & False Peace in: self, wisdom, education, money, retirement, or seclusion

I. A Saving Peace with God

Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Romans 5:1

- Saved from Sin
- Saved from the Devil's Power
- Saved from God

For if when <u>we were enemies we were reconciled to God</u> through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. Romans 5:10

II. A Personal Peace Within

Jesus: "Peace I leave with you. My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid." John 14:27

III. A Relational Peace with Each Other

And <u>let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you</u>
<u>were called in one body</u>; and be thankful. Colossians 3:15

For <u>He Himself is our peace</u>, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation, having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace, and that <u>He might reconcile them both to God</u> in one body through the cross...  & agalliasis (gladness at arrival/special guest)
- Rejoice—Greek: chairō (gladness expressed)
 & kauchaomai (to boast in or glory in)

Joy is a Choice, Not a Feeling

My brethren, <u>count it all joy</u> when you fall into various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. James 1:2-3

Joy is Based on Truth, Not on Circumstances

In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be you have been grieved by various trials, that the genuineness of your faith, being much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ, whom having not seen you love. Though now you do not see Him, yet believing, you rejoice with Joy inexpressible and full of glory, receiving the end of your faith—the salvation of yours youls. 1 Peter 1:6-9

Joy is the Produce of <u>Obedience</u>, Not a Result of Prosperity

But the fruit of the Spirit is love<u>, joy</u>, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Galatians 5:22

- The Most Joyless Person isn't the Worldly, Lost Sinner.
- It's the Christian Living like the World.

"Savior" in Greek: So-tare = To Save/Preserve

"And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call <u>His name</u> <u>IESUS. for He will save</u> His people from their sins." Matthew 1-21

Iesus = Ioshua = Iehovah Saves

But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His Name. John 1-12

"<u>Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name</u> under heaven given among men by which we must be <u>saved</u>." Acts 4-12

Salvation belongs to the LORD, Your blessing is upon Your people. Psalm 3:8 & Jonah 2:9

And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent the Son as Savior of the world. 1 John 4:14

2. Exclusivity [God]

Jesus: "I am the way, the truth, and the life<u>. No one comes to the Father except through Me.</u>" John 14:6

3. Eternality
