Thessalonians: The Model Church in a Depraved Culture 1 Thessalonians 2:1-6

For you yourselves know, brethren, that our coming to you was not in vain. But even after we had suffered before and were spitefully treated at Philippi, as you know, we were bold in our God to speak to you the gospel of God in much conflict. For our exhortation did not come from error or uncleanness, nor was it in deceit. But as we have been approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel, even so we speak, not as pleasing men, but God who tests our hearts. For neither at any time did we use flattering words, as you know, nor a cloak for covetousness—God is witness. Nor did we seek glory from men, either from you or from others, when we might have made demands as quostles of Christ. 1 Thessalonians 21-6

[Treatment at Philippi = Acts 16:16-24]

Fact: The culture's reaction to your faith, message, and mission is a good indicator of your authenticity/accuracy.

Question: How did they respond to and treat Jesus?

Today's Approach: How do teachers overcome opposition?

Answer: Water down the Gospel. Good News Only.Drop Divisive Doctrine. Incorporate the Culture. Concede Social Issues.

If anyone teaches otherwise and does not agree to the sound instruction of our Lord Jesus Christ and to godly teaching, they are conceited and <u>understand nothing</u>...Timothy, guard what has been entrusted to your care. Turn away from godless chatter and the opposing ideas of what is falsely called knowledge.which some have professed and in so doing have departed from the faith. 1 Timothy 6:3-4 & 20-21 (NIV) <u>Obviously, I'm not trying to win the approval of people</u>, but of God. If pleasing people were my goal, I would not be Christ's servant. Galatians 1:10 (NLT)

Biblical Leadership that Produces Godly Members

But we, brethren, having been taken away from you for a short time in presence, not in heart, endeavored more eagerly to see your face with great desire. Therefore we wanted to come to you—even I, Paul, time and again—but Satan hindered us. For what is our hope, or joy, or crown of rejoicing? Is it not even you in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at His coming? For you are our glory and joy.

Paul's Critics = "Paul's fear is greater than his love & concern for you. Therefore, listen to and follow us."

Thessalonians: Model Behavior—Part 1 1 Thessalonians 4:1-8

...you received from us how you ought to walk and to please God; for you know what commandments we gave you through the Lord Jesus. For this is the will of God, your sanctification: that you should abstain from sexual immorality; that each of you should know how to possess his own vessel in sanctification and honor, not in passion of lust, like the Gentiles who do not know God...For God did not call us to uncleanness, but in holiness. Therefore, he who rejects this does not reject man, but God, who has also given us His Holy Spirit.

1 Thessalonians 4:1-8

- "through the Lord Jesus" vs. Paul (man) & verse 8 = "rejects...God"

Therefore, do not be unwise, but <u>understand what the will of</u> <u>the Lord is</u>. And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit. Ephesians 5:17-18

Truth: God wants you to know His will. Truth: The worst time to make the decision = When you are under the influence of something else.

God's Will:

Now we command you, brothers, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you keep away from every brother who walks in an unruly manner and not according to the tradition which they received from us...For even when we were with you, we used to command this to you: if anyone is not willing to work, neither let him eat. For we hear that some among you are walking in an unruly manner, doing no work at all, but acting like busybodies. Now such persons we command and exhort in the Lord Jesus Christ, that working with quietness, they eat their own bread. 2 Thessalonians 3:6 & 10-12

- Idleness Results in Progressive Transgression

Upside Down Entitlement

1. Paul's Example:

For you yourselves know how you ought to imitate us, because we did not act in an unruly manner among you, nor did we eat anyone's bread without paying for it, but with labor and hardship we kept working night and day so that we would not be a burden to any of you;... ...not because <u>we do not have the authority, but in order to offer</u> ourselves as a model for you, so that you would imitate us. 2 Thessalonians 3:7-9

2. Paul's Authority or Right

The elders who lead well are to be considered worthy of double honor, especially those who labor at preaching the word and teaching, 1 Timothy 5:17 (LSB & NKJV) [Deuteronomy 25:4 & Luke 10:7]

So also the Lord directed those who proclaim the Gospel to get their living from the Gospel. 1 Corinthians 9:14

Redefining Disability: Bringing the World into the Church

Church Policy: <u>Refuse</u>

... if anyone is not willing to work, neither let him eat. Verse 10

Church Discipline: <u>Remove</u>

...you keep away from every brother who walks in an unruly manner... Verse 6 (& 14)

Church Goal: <u>Restore</u>

Sufficient for such a one is this punishment which was inflicted by the majority, so that on the contrary you should rather graciously forgive and comfort him, lest such a one be swallowed up by excessive sorrow. Therefore, <u>Lencourage you to</u> <u>reaffirm your love for him</u>. 2 Corinthians 2:6-8
