

Revelation Review—part 2

Questions, Answers, and Review from Sunday's sermon: the 2nd half of the 7-year Tribulation is so bad, the Bible calls it the Great Tribulation. 2 great events happen—one in Heaven and one on Earth. (Both discussed below) The world experiences the wrath of both God and Satan. All of Creation is systematically undone. All the while, Christ is Glorified.

As the 2nd Half Begins, what great event takes place in Heaven? <u>Satan and the demons are kicked</u> <u>out, never to have access again.</u> See *Revelation 12:7-12*

Was learning that Satan visits heaven's throne room a surprise to you? What other passages/stories tell us about the devil's access to heaven?

As the 2nd Half Begins, what great event takes place on Earth? <u>Antichrist survives mortal wound.</u> Now takes over world, Jerusalem/Temple, all aspects of life. Demands to be worshipped. See *Daniel 9:27 & Revelation 13:14-15*

On Sunday, it was mentioned that Adam's fall affected more than all mankind. What else became tainted and doomed that day? All of creation See Romans 8:19-22

Complete and Discuss the Following Chart to explain "Creation Undone"

Genesis account

Revelation Parallels (Undone)

1:3-5—God Created Light	God sends darkness over the entire earth (Rev. 6, 8, & 16)
1:6-8— <u>Separated Heaven from Creation</u>	The veil that separates man from seeing spirit removed (Rev. 6:14)
1:9-13—Creation of Land, Seas, Trees, Plants	Land/mountains/Islands destroyed. Plants grass burned (Rev. 8 & 16)
1:14-19—Creation of Sun, Moon, Stars	Heavens shaken, stars fall, sun goes dark (Rev. 6, 8, & 16)
1:20-23—Creation of Sea Life and Birds	Seas/waters turned to blood. Animals die under plagues (Rev. 6,8, & 16)
1:24-24-31—Creation of land animals & man	blood waters kill all animals. Man destroyed throughout

With all these destroyed by the end of the Tribulation, will the Millennium and eternity just be a barren wasteland? Not at all! It will be Paradise restored. See also *Revelation 21:1-5*

When you think of the book of Revelation, what words/descriptions come to mind? <u>Various answers: wrath, death, destruction, evil, judgment....</u>

Yet, on Sunday, it was pointed out that more than 40% of the Book is what? Worship and Praise *Chapters 1, 4, 5, 7, 10, 14, 15, 19, 21, & 22

Discuss the truth that God just as worthy of praise for wrath/judgment as He is for salvation/grace.
