

## John: The Great "I AM" Gospel John 9:1-12 From Sermon 3.17.24

Read John 9:1-12

Overview from Sunday's sermon: <u>As our study transitions from chapter 8 to chapter 9, our mock courtroom sees the return of submitted evidence (miracles) vs testimony only. The great account of Jesus healing the man born blind brings up many questions—some quite deep. Since the man's encounter with Jesus is similar to our salvation story, it is important and meaningful to explore those questions together.</u>

- 1. How is Jesus' healing of the man born blind an illustration of our own salvation? The entire encounter was pre-planned by Jesus. Out of all the blind beggars, Jesus chose him. The man was born into his condition and situation. He could do nothing on his own to change his fate. Jesus did all the work. Once the man was washed, he could clearly see the real Jesus. The man gave testimony to the power of Christ.
- 2. What were/are your thoughts on Jesus' method of healing in this account? <u>Various Personal Answers.</u> Why did He use clay made with His own saliva? <u>We have no idea.</u> What are we to do with this unusual method? <u>Just accept it and move on.</u> It's not a formula for healings today.
- 3. From Sunday, Answer and Discuss the Truth and Causes of Suffering and Pain
